


Why do I need a RSR Club Licence?

- You can participate in RSR Club Racing events and MSA Regional events. You need a MSA licence for both. To apply for a MSA Licence you need to belong to a registered MSA affiliated club.
- For you to race in RSR Club Racing events you can apply at RSR for a Social Licence (**See note below**) or a Club licence from MSA.
- For you to race on MSA Regional Events you at least need a MSA Club Licence. All depends on which class you want to compete.
- Special RSR Club Licence Holder discounts from time to time during the year for both Track Events and Shop Specials. Watch site for notifications on special rates for club members.

How Do I apply for a MSA Licence?

- Get your RSR Club Membership from Red Star Raceway.
 - Apply Online for a MSA Licence at www.msaonline.co.za
 - They will send you a temporary licence on email and you make arrangements to get your yearly licence from them.
 - When you want to compete you need to show the temporary license or the permanent license.

Social Club Licence:

- Only First time competitors may apply. (This means that you have attended track days but not competed in any race events).
- Social Club licence is only valid till the end of this year (2011).
- You need to have a RSR Club Membership to apply for a Social Licence.
- As soon as you apply for a club licence from MSA then your social licence will be cancelled.
- Cost for this licence is R200.
