



RSR 'Challenge your Dream' Class

1. Eligibility of Riders

1. Any rider who holds a MSA Regional or Club License
2. One day event licenses will not apply
3. Riders will be eligible to compete from their 17th birthday.

2. Eligibility of Motorcycles

The CYD Class shall be open to the following classes:

Motorcycles with a capacity greater than 500cc four stroke.

Turbo charging, supercharging or nitrous oxide boosting is not permitted.

3. Technical Regulations & Specifications

There are no restrictions on the permitted modifications in this class providing that the motorcycle complies with any applicable MSA GCR'S AND SSR'S.

Tyres are restricted to tyres being imported by the recognised importers.

Silencers must be fitted to all motorcycles.

4. Competition Numbers

1. Competition numbers will be allocated on a first come first serve basis as entries are received.
2. All numbers must be black on a white background in an Arial Bold font.

5. Starting Order

1. Starting positions for heat 1 will be based on each rider's best lap time set during qualifying. The fastest lap time starting on the front of the grid.
2. Riders who do not set a time in qualifying will start from the back of the grid.
3. Grid positions for race 2 shall be determined according to each competitor's second quickest lap time set in qualifying.

6. Point Scoring

7. Overall results

1. Overall positions for the day will be determined by the total points scored during each heat.
2. A tie in points will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the greater number of first positions, failing this seconds, thirds, etc. If a tie still remains, it will be resolved in favour of the competitor with the best finishing position in the final heat on the day.
